Mag. Paul Schuster Schloss Eggenberg in Graz Creating the residence for a new dynasty

Schloss Eggenberg in Graz (AUT) is a unique synthesis of the arts dating back to the early Baroque period where architecture and design combine to create a complex symbolist representation of the universe, the cosmos of an educated statesman. The residence of Imperial Governor Hans Ulrich von Eggenberg is political architecture established to express the powerful legitimation of the rule of a family. The architectural design of his new residence, moreover, offers important insights into ceremonial space and court ceremony at the imperial Habsburg court around 1620/30.
